
## Grade 4-8 Speaking

Overall expectations:	How EP supports these expectations:	
<p>B1. Speaking to Communicate: communicate information and ideas orally in French, using a variety of speaking strategies and age- and grade-appropriate language suited to the purpose and audience;</p>	<p>In each of our levelled, topic-based units we have a speaking lesson which includes activities focusing on both pronunciation and communication.</p> <p>The pronunciation sections require students to record themselves saying words and sentences which they can then compare to a model answer recorded by a native speaker.</p> <p>The communication sections require students to listen to a series of questions and record their answer, then listen to a series of answers and record a question that might get that answer. Speaking to Interact: participate in spoken interactions in French for a variety of purposes and with diverse audiences;</p>	<p>As part of our speaking lessons, we have a series of questions which require students to listen to a question and record their answer and then listen to a series of answers and record an appropriate question. These are designed to prepare students for interacting in a variety of situations with different purposes and audiences.</p> <p>Our speaking lessons also include role play tasks to go alongside each of the units, where students are required to record conversations and role plays with a partner.</p> <p>Teachers are able to easily create additional questions of this nature and give feedback on what the students have recorded.</p>	<p>Enregistrez un dialogue en français avec un ami. Intercultural Understanding: in their spoken communications, demonstrate an awareness of aspects of culture in diverse French-speaking communities and other communities around the world, and of the appropriate use of French sociolinguistic conventions in a variety of situations.</p>	<p>Our speaking tasks include questions demonstrating an awareness of French culture. <p>C1. Reading Comprehension: determine meaning in a variety of French texts, using a range of reading comprehension strategies;</p>	<p>In each of our levelled topic-based units, we have a reading comprehension lesson. This contains a large selection of reading texts which include a wide range of text types, accompanied by a variety of different types of questions.</p> <p>Teachers can also easily create additional reading comprehension questions to suit their needs.</p> <p>Our course also contains a wide selection of grammar lessons and vocabulary lists which help students to develop all of their key skills.</p>	<p>Lisez le texte ci-dessous et répondez à la question en français :</p> <p>Identifiez le but de cette conversation. Some of these will be available from September 2020.</p>
